

"We recognize that many parents and kids do not talk about sexual bullying, harassment and pressures because they are deeply uncomfortable with the topic and lack knowledge. Parents will often assume – incorrectly – that their kids would come to them if they had a problem, and kids assume – incorrectly – that their parents don't know anything and couldn't possibly help them. Today's teens are greatly challenged by the violent and misogynistic messages in the media they consume and their own impulsiveness and risk-taking behaviour. They need – and actually want – adults to listen to them and guide them without lectures and judgment. The film provides many examples and opportunities for families to discover their own path."

Parents are encouraged to bring their children to see the film and hear the discussion.

However, please be advised that the film is for a Grade 9 - 12 audience and contains mature themes and some coarse language. It would not be suitable for younger children.
